In the summer of 2003, Beth was diagnosed with Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis /ALS, also known as Lou Gehrig's Disease, a neuro-muscular disease with no known cure. Patients with ALS typically have an average of 2 to 5 years life expectancy, with medical costs in the final stages of the disease approaching \$250,000.00 annually.
